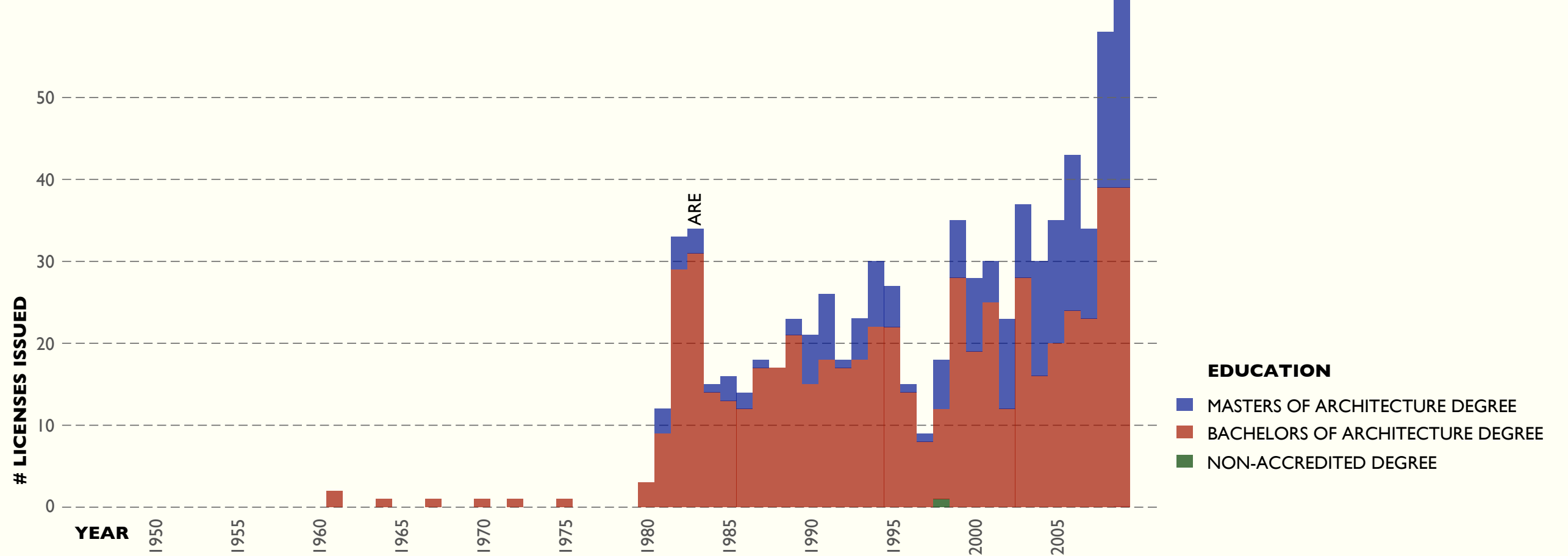
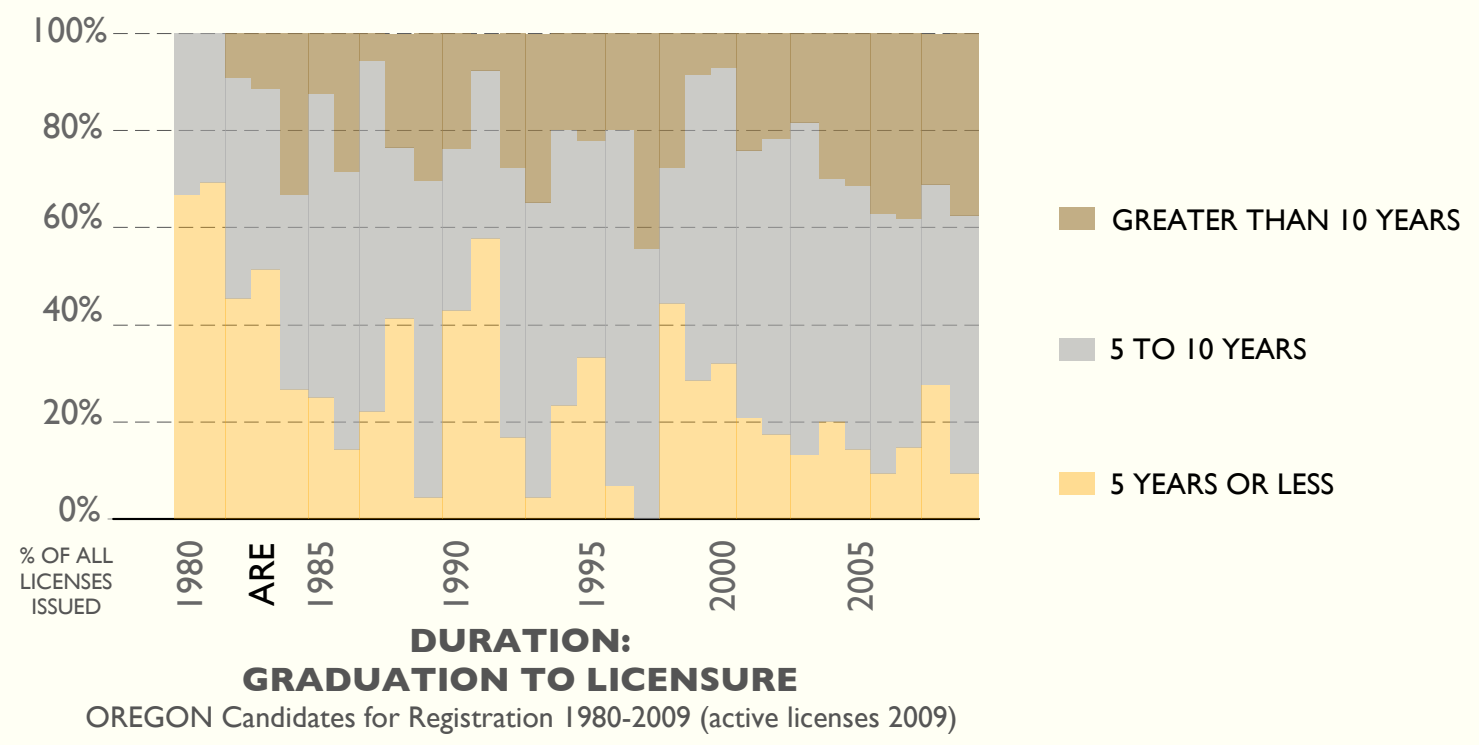

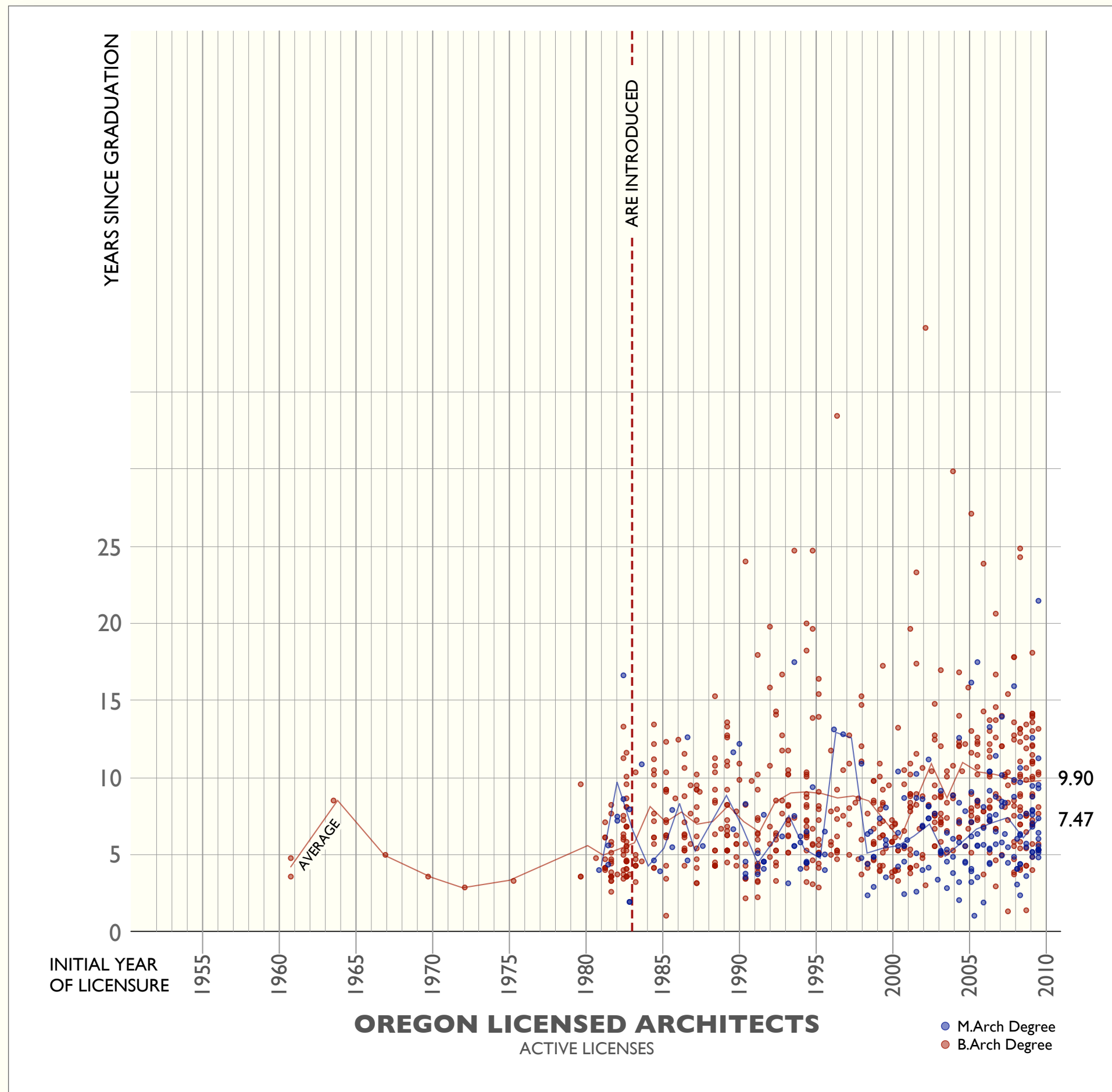

Background:
On October 2, 2009, I sent the following request to the Nebraska Board of Engineers & Architects:

Dear Ms Moeller:

Last year I attempted to conduct a study of internship in architecture, specifically attempting to track licensure rates for graduates of accredited schools of architecture in the US. NCARB and NAAB make some information regarding these issues available to the public, but the information they publish is insufficient for the purposes of my study. I prepared charts of this data, which made clear to me the need for a more thorough examination of the issues. This resulted in a Request for Information which I presented to the NCARB IDP Advisory Committee last fall. The charts and the request are posted online at

It has become clear that the information I am looking for is not available on a national basis, and I am writing to ask if you can provide me with any information in this regard for Oregon.

What I am looking for is historical data on an annual basis of newly licensed architects (not necessarily reciprocal licenses), in relation to the year of graduation and the educational institution that issued the qualifying degree. I realize this request could be seen as creating a significant amount of work to extract, and that is not my intention; I would like to learn what information is publicly available, if any, and what is the appropriate method for me to request it.

I believe that significant changes in the way architects are created have occurred, and my efforts are an attempt to discover the duration architectural interns are currently experiencing in their path to becoming architects. My research is intended to provide an accurate picture of internship as it is being practiced in the US today. I am grateful for any assistance you can provide.

On October 5, I received this reply:

If you wish to request a list of exam candidates that are active, we have information that we can provide to you in the following format:

License number, date registered, school, degree, and date of degree.

Right now, we have 785 individuals on that list (fluctuates all the time). The cost would be \$50. Please send me a check for that amount with a copy of this email and I'll make sure you get the right information.

As we go back in time, this information is not available, but we do have this much right now. Let me know how you wish to proceed.

On December 2, I received the list upon which this chart is based, accompanied by this letter:

Enclosed with this letter is the list you requested from the Oregon Board of Architect Examiners of all those newly licensed in Oregon by examination that have the university, degree, and date of degree in the Board's records. There are 800 individuals on that list.

The Board currently has 1,069 active licensees that were originally licensed by examination. The enclosed list shows 800 individuals. The remaining 269 individuals do not have the information in the Board's database. This is an ongoing project and will take time to complete. As you know this is not a priority at this time, but I am hopeful that it can be accomplished over the next few months.

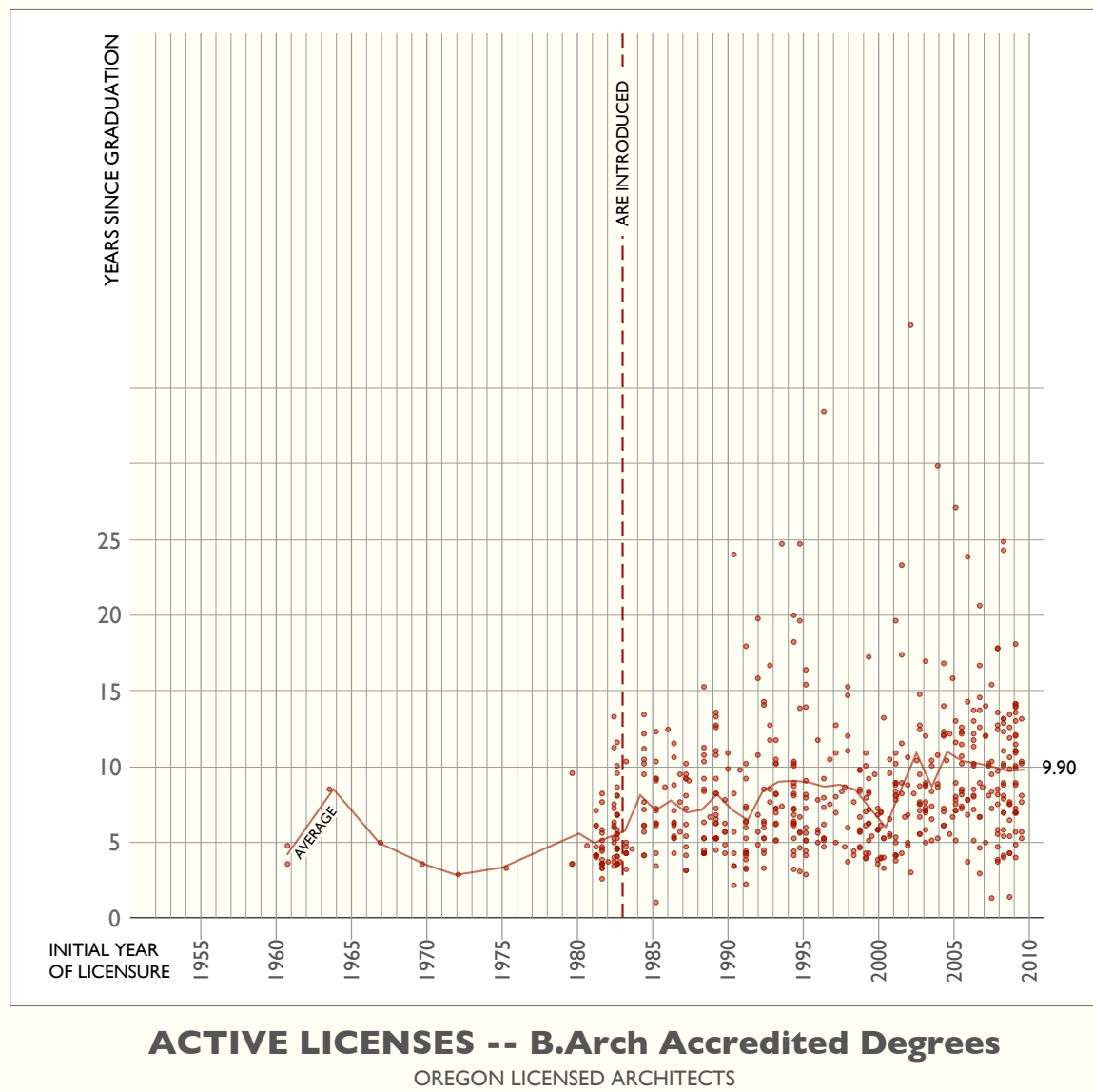
The Board currently also has 1,680 active licenses that were originally licensed by reciprocity. Later, these records will also be updated -- over time.

I hope this information is helpful to you. If you have any questions or the Board may assist you further, please let me know.

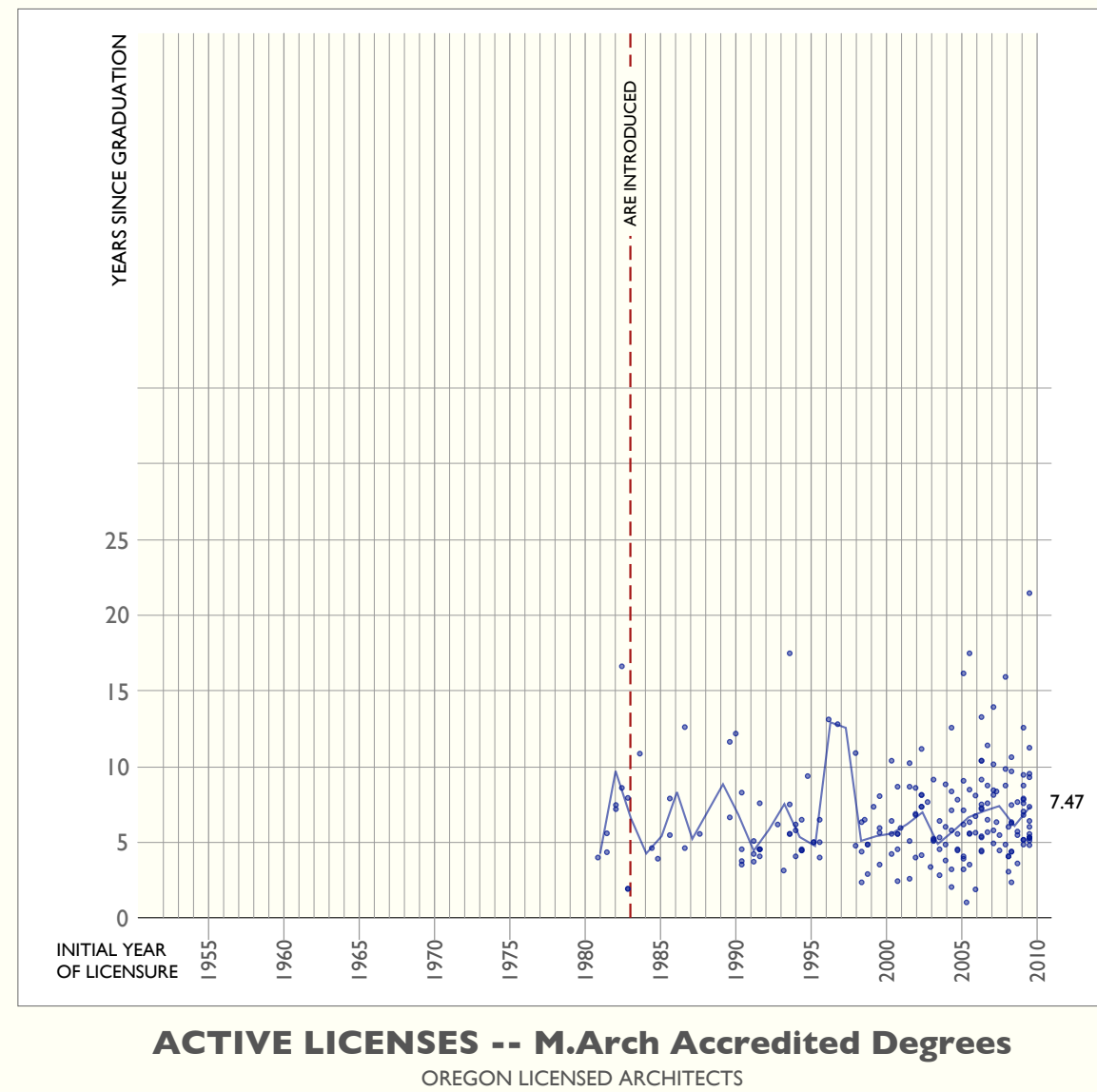
